

OSTA Club Team Challenge Program for 2012 Ohio State Shoot  
Effective 7/16/11  
Updated 7/13/11

The Club Team Challenge program is designed to help the smaller clubs get more shooters to participate in ATA registered events.

Each club that is authorized to hold ATA registered events in the state of Ohio can participate. Each club has the option to hold a Club Team Challenge qualifier event. The event must be so noted when making application to hold the shoot. Application for a Club Team Challenge initial qualifier must be made 14 calendar days prior to the scheduled event date with the OSTA secretary. Application for a Club Team Challenge rescheduled qualifier must be made 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled event date with the OSTA secretary.

Event qualifiers will be held on a 100 target program for singles. The high Non Category score along with the high score by category for Jr./Sub Jr., Lady, Veteran and Senior Veteran will qualify for the Club Team Challenge award at the Ohio State shoot. Multiple categories if applicable may be declared at qualifying events.

Event winners must have qualifying club name, event, shooter name, ATA number and the type of qualification (non category, jr./sub jr., lady, veteran, senior veteran) identified on the shoot report and submitted to the OSTA secretary only after a complete team has been assembled.

A minimum of 1 unique shooter per type of the five categories is required for the event to be considered a valid qualifier. Multiple qualifiers can be hosted in order to complete the requirements for sponsoring a Club Team Challenge complete team. Once a category has been filled from a qualifier, said category is considered filled should additional qualifiers be needed to field a complete team.

At the Ohio State shoot all qualifiers will have their scores recorded for the singles championship. Ties for Club Team Challenge team champion will be determined by a high card draw.

Shooters may qualify at different clubs for the same or different category. Shooters do not need to be a resident of Ohio to participate in this program. The Club Team Challenge qualifier must not be held in conjunction with the Champion of Champions program. Each of these programs is separate and distinct and must be held on different dates.
